

Menelic Roero Arneis

14% abv 750mL

Produced by Emanuele Rolfo in Roero, a small area in Piedmont. The sandy soils rich with fossils produce whites that are fragrantly perfumed with great minerality. Arneis (literally: "little rascal") is so called because it is regarded as a somewhat difficult variety to grow.

An intensely floral, spicy aroma entices the nose of this wine. The palate is round and harmonic, full, savory and balanced with a long finish. A perfect pairing for light appetizers or seafood dishes.
