Wine Making	Traditional plot by plot wine making. After total destemming, maceration of 3 to 5 weeks in thermoregulated vats, with regular pumping overs.
Ageing	During 12 months in oak barrels
Blend	90% Merlot 10% Cabernet-Franc,
Dégustation	The nose reveals red fruit, fresh and mature. On the palate, the structure is smooth with beautiful tanins. A lot of freshness for this very accessible wine.
